

Madison Township Fire Department and Madison Township Firefighters IAFF Local 2507 are proud to offer the residents of Madison Township the means to store and maintain vital medical information. It's a bracelet and a computer memory device known as a USB and has been introduced to the public at the Board meeting on March 19, 2014.

When plugged into a computer, the information can be viewed like a web page in an internet browser. When first opened, the pages prompt you to enter data by filling in the blanks. Once completed the information can then be printed and kept in a safe location in the home, and wearing the bracelet keeps the same vital information with you if needed by emergency and hospital personnel. The information is accessed by plugging the bracelet into a USB drive on a computer.

We will have these devices for sale at both of our Fire Stations for twenty dollars. proceeds will be used to fund future public safety projects. Group presentation and education sessions may be scheduled for a more indepth look at the benefits of wearing a data bracelet. Contact us for more information, 614-837-7883.
