

NEW UPDATE FROM PUCO - TRANSMISSION COSTS April 7, 2015

Residents can expect phone calls and changes in their June 2015 billing (July invoices) due to a recent Opinion and Order from the PUCO regarding AEP Ohio's ESPIII case. This affects ALL customers, not just aggregation members. Madison Township residents that are participating in the contract with IGS Energy will see two changes. The transmission charge will (in July) appear under the AEP section of your invoice and your IGS Energy rate will decrease to approximately .0599 (yes this should be roughly 1 cent lower than the current rate).

Other suppliers may contact you and tell you that they can offer you a lower rate, BE SURE YOU COMPARE APPLES TO APPLES. In the long run you may not save ANY MONEY verses the aggregation program or the utility default rate.

The rates should include the AEP charges for distribution and transmission service, along with your customer charges and riders. (this is effective June 1 2015, shows on July bills). The supplier charges will only be for generation service. YOU SHOULD NOT RECEIVE A CALL FROM IGS.

Anyone that contacts you between now and July may present you much lower offers to get you to switch. THESE OFFERS WILL NOT INCLUDE THE Transmission Service charges, thus in the long run you will not save ANY MONEY. The Transmission Service is about 1 cent of the current rate.
